Re: Docket No. 03-09-08RE01 – Applications of The Connecticut Light and Power Company and The United Illuminating Company for Issuance of Financing Order – Funding for the Energy Conservation and Load Management Fund and the Renewable Energy Investment Fund

Dear Ms. Rickard:

Order No. 3 of the Department of Public Utility Control's ("Department") decision dated April 30, 2008 in the above-captioned proceeding ("Decision") requires The United Illuminating Company ("UI" or "Company") to submit a compliance rate filing with equal offsetting adjustments to the Conservation and Load Management Fund ("CLM") and Renewable Investment Fund ("REI") charges "to reflect the removal of the RRB Charge from the Competitive Transition Assessment charge." Decision at 5. The order contemplates this compliance filing to be made within 10 days of the closing of the defeasance of the rate reduction bonds ("RRBs") as described in the Decision.¹

In addition to the rate changes that result from the defeasance of the RRB's, there are numerous other rate components whose charges will change as of July 1, 2008. These include changes to the (i) generation services charge for Last Resort Service ("LRS"), (ii) generation services charge for Standard Service (approved in Docket No. 07-11-31), and (iii) retail transmission charge. Changes to the LRS generation service charge and the retail transmission charge are the subjects of administrative proceedings in other dockets.

Rather than providing a compliance rate filing as contemplated in the Decision, followed by additional rate filings due to the additional rate changes noted above, UI intends to submit one full set of tariff sheets to reflect all of the changes that will be effective as of July 1, 2008 (including the changes contemplated by the Decision). The Company

expects to make this filing on or about June 25, 2008 as a compliance filing in the administrative proceeding addressing LRS generation service charge changes.²
